Allergies: Bees

Reaction: localised swelling, potential for anaphylaxis

In the event of a sting, watch for signs of anaphylaxis

- Swelling of tongue/lips
- Breathing difficulties
- Swallowing difficulties
- Funny cough
- Seizure

If above signs are present

1. Sit John up and try to keep him calm
2. Contact parent Tom 123 456 789 – parent to administer epipen
3. Call 000 ambulance
4. CPR
5. Remove sting and apply ice

If no signs present

1. Remove sting and apply ice
2. Contact parent Tom – parent to administer anti histamine

Check for signs of anaphylactic reaction
Swollen lips or tongue?
Breathing or swallowing difficulties?
Funny cough not previously there?
